

TRIMBLE LOCAL SCHOOLS WALL OF FAME

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Trimble Local Schools Wall of Fame is twofold. First, to honor individuals that attended any of the schools that were part of the merger to form Trimble Local Schools; that have become successful in his/her profession; and/or have been active and made a meaningful contribution to Trimble Township. Secondly, to demonstrate to our current students that Trimble Township has developed many outstanding citizens.

CRITERIA FOR NOMINATION

1. To be nominated, an individual must have attended Glouster, Jacksonville-Trimble, Hollister, Greens Run, Trimble, or any other school that was part of the merger to form Trimble Local Schools
2. Must be successful in his/her profession
and/or
3. Have been active and made a meaningful contribution to Trimble Township.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

1. The original members of the selection committee were chosen by the high school principal.
2. The selection committee will consist of ten voting members. The first committee selection will consist of four members serving four year terms, four members serving three year terms, and two members serving two year terms.
3. When any vacancies occur new appointments will be made at the discretion of the Wall of Fame committee.

SELECTION METHOD

1. Each year, the public will be given proper notice that nominations for the Wall of Fame are being accepted.
2. Nominations from the public must be made in writing to the selection committee on a completed application form to:

3. There is no limit to the number of people who can be nominated. All people nominated who meet the requirements for consideration will be placed on a master list of nominees. There is no limit to the number of times a person can be considered for

election to the Wall of Fame and it is not necessary to submit a new nomination for an individual unless additional information is being provided.

4. The selection committee's responsibility will be to process the nominations and select the inductees from the master list of written applications through a voting process.

NUMBER OF INDUCTEES

1. The number of individuals inducted the first year will be no more than six. Thereafter, the number of inductees will be no more than five as determined by the members of the committee.

INDUCTION

1. Induction of new members of the Wall of Fame will take place once each school year, beginning 2002-03. The date of the ceremony shall be determined by the committee in conjunction with school officials.

2. Those to be inducted will be contacted by the committee to obtain photos and any other information required to prepare for the induction ceremony or any related activities.

3. The yearly ceremony and presentation of awards will be conducted by the Wall of Fame committee.

4. Each inductee will be given a commemorative award. The names will also be part of a permanent display at the high school. Photos may be part of the Wall of Fame display if possible.

5. Although not mandatory, attendance at the induction ceremony is vital to its success. Candidates are encouraged to attend.

FUNDING

1. Funding for the project will be handled by the Wall of Fame selection committee. Funding shall be established by accepting donations. Any individual, group or organization may make a donation.
